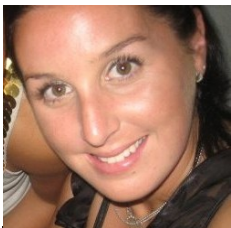

On Saturday 5 June, the 2010 Women's Australian Hockey League (AHL) Tournament came to a conclusion with the Victorian Vipers finishing fourth, defeated by NSW in the golden goal period of the 3rd place final match. In the AHL grand final WA defeated Queensland 3 – 1 to be the 2010 AHL Champions, their fourth title in six years and Queensland's fifth successive loss in an AHL grand final. The tournament commenced on 7 May and was hosted by Hobart, Brisbane, Perth, Darwin and the finals in Adelaide.

Hawthorn had a significant representation in the 2010 Victorian Vipers with **Megan Beriman, Kary Chau, Claire Messent and Penny Richardson** featuring in the team.

Megan, Kary and Claire were all goal scorers for the Vipers through the tournament, while at the other end goal keeper Penny shared the net for the Vipers with fellow keeper and Australian keeper, Rachael Lynch.

In earlier games in the tournament against Queensland Megan contributed to the 3 – 0 victory scoring the first goal of the game with a great deflection on a penalty corner. Kary completed this Vipers solid victory converting a penalty stroke with 6 minuets to go. Against NT Kary was the second to score in the 3 – 0 victory from a clever finish from a tight angle. The third goal of that game came from handy Hawks team work when Kary's initial shot on goal deflected off the goal keeper conveniently to Claire who swatted the ball high into the net. Against WA, playing for a sport in the 3rd place final match, Claire scored the winning goal at the 16 minute mark.

WPA: Hawthorn 4 v Doncaster 6

In probably the wettest conditions we will have this season (or any other) Pennant A went down 6-4 to Doncaster. After a positive start, Pennant A converted a penalty corner through Susie Widmer and went up 1-0. Despite creating several more promising opportunities, the Doncaster goalkeeper and defence were determined to prevent us from making any further impact on the scoreboard. At the other end, we were not so resilient and allowed Doncaster to put away a couple of goals and go into the break leading 3-1.

By the start of the second half, the weather had further deteriorated. H1 was soaking wet making jink passes or strong hits the only safe way to move the ball around the field. After letting another goal slip by, the attitude of the Hawks group improved and we earned a bundle of short corners. We were able to convert 3 more (2 excellent deflections from Mimi and second straight hit from Susie) tying the scores at 4-4. Doncaster took the initiative and quickly got a goal back at the other end making it 5-4 and then 6-4 quickly thereafter. Unfortunately by that stage the weather was unbearable and with the field under about 10cm of water, it was impossible to move the ball more than 10 yards! Although the final result was disappointing, this week Pennant A showed much improvement and hopefully in the coming weeks we can ensure the scoreboard reflects this.

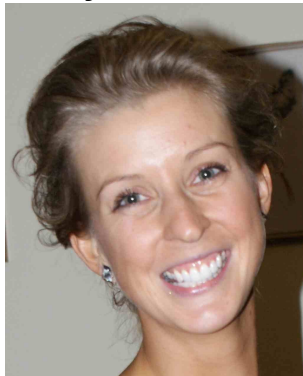
