- Fielded 5 teams, WPL, WPLR, WPA, WPB, WPE
- WPL, WPLR, WPA into finals, with WPA winning the Grand Final
- WPL had 7 new players from the 2019 team, including 3 internationals
- Noticeable drop in player numbers from previous years, (a total of 85 players) however we welcomed 14 juniors playing seniors for the first time across all teams

### Things that worked well in season 2022

- Dedicated WPLR coach, who encouraged the “have-a-go attitude”, for inexperienced players, supported by WPL players doubling up throughout the season
- Having an experienced and dedicated coach/international player to take Pennant training each week and to coach when possible, Pen B, which was mostly juniors
- Having junior inexperienced players, mix with older players in lowest grade

### Ideas or areas for improvement

- Changing the training night for Pennant players, to increase numbers and to not clash with Master's games
- Look at a PL squad coordinator & a Pennant coordinator for selections and communication
- Encourage more experienced players to support the Junior Club
- Reach out again to previous players to increase the selection base, especially due to holidays and sickness

# AGM 2022 Juniors Report

The juniors had a generally successful 2022 in terms of getting kids back into the routine of team sport: getting fit, learning new skills and developing friendships.

We had a total of **157** juniors playing in **10** winter teams including a small group of U8s who played in the gala at Doncaster. There were two U10 teams playing in the Flames competition: with girls making up 15 of the 18 players.

We had a Shield A team in each of the boys age groups U12, U14, U16, plus Pennant teams at U12 and U14. There are fewer girls in this age group with only an U12 girls Shield A team and U14 girls Shield B team. Unfortunately, we were unable to enter an U16 girls team due to insufficient player numbers but many of the girls in that age group enjoyed playing with our women's seniors teams.

Based on current registrations and the players moving into their 2023 age groups, I expect we will enter a very similar number and composition of teams as this year and hopefully including an U16 girls team.

One highlight of 2022 was our U14 boys Shield team winning their semi-final against a strong Footscray team in a penalty shoot-out, but our boys were unfortunately beaten 2:1 by Waverly in the grand-final.

Thanks to all the club volunteers who helped out with juniors this year: coaches, team managers, coordinators and the parents who transport the players across Melbourne every Friday night and / or Saturday morning. Special thanks go to Toni Fleming for coaching our super Hi2H squad, Indy for taking on the challenge of U10s and Tony Darby for developing our U12 Shield boys. Also a huge thanks to our Premier League players Jonah, Adam, Sam, Hannah and Jeremy for their efforts in coaching our juniors.

For me this year has been a huge learning curve but I have had really great support from all the club committee. Rookie, in particular, has spent many hours online past midnight getting me up to speed with the technology, processes and HV regulations so I'm now in a good position to roll out teams in 2023.

My focus next year will be to increase participation of players and provide support and development for our coaches and hopefully get a few more of our teams playing finals. Thanks for your support this year and I'm looking forward to getting involved again next year.



## 2022 Season Report – Men's Masters

2022 was a year of getting back on the pitch on a consistent basis. We had around 50 players for most of the season although it did appear that we did have a few longer lasting injuries as a result losing a lot of game time and fitness over the preceding two years. The most successful of our Monday Men's Masters was the 45+ BSE team which finished 4th on the ladder with 6 wins, 4 draws and 8 losses. Following in skill order were the 45+CSE team at 6th on the ladder 7 wins and 5 draws and 5 losses and the 45+ D team at 8th on the ladder with only 4 wins although they did finish above Camberwell Blue this year.

## 2022 Season Report – Women's Masters

It has been another exciting 12 months for the Women's Masters group at Hawthorn. We had an influx of new players for the Term 4 2021 summer season, and fielded 3 teams in that competition. Emboldened by the new players, we decided to field 3 teams in the HV winter competitions as well.

With much excitement, especially from the more 'mature aged' members of the Women's Masters group, we fielded teams in the WM35A, WM35BC and WM45+ age group divisions in winter 2022.

As ever, an enormous thanks to our team managers for their contribution and efforts each week and their ongoing support of the section, as well as to the more than 40 players turning out for Women's Masters who hopefully had fun, kept fit and made some new friends. Of note is the fact that around 20 of the Women's Masters players also 'double up' at weekends and play in and support the women's division, as well as some who coach and manage Junior teams and a few who also play Men's Masters/Open on a Monday evening.

### Winter 2022

Our 35A team was blessed with some new and returning players, who helped to strengthen the team even further. Ably managed by Sophie Dall'Ava each week and coached by Kate Stebbings, at the end of the season the 35A team was sitting in 3rd place and in finals for the first time at this level. A 3-1 victory in the semi-finals in atrocious weather at Doncaster was well deserved, but sadly we bowed out the following week, losing 2-0 to old foes from Mentone. Kate Stebbings was voted as our Most Valuable Player, and was top scorer for the season. We also farewelled Emma Rockey mid season, who returned to live in the UK - Emma will be sorely missed.

Playing numbers throughout the season were at times severely impacted by COVID, injury and holidays, and there were a few occasions where our 35B team struggled to field a team at all, let alone a full team. Assisted throughout the season at home games and some away games by 35A and 45+ players doubling up, the 35B's finished the season with 5 wins and 1 draw, and notably lost 7 of its games by 2 goals or less. With a couple more players to fill up the team in the 2023 winter season, this group will go from strength to strength. Congratulations to Shelley Meagher, our MVP for the 35B team in 2022.

Our new 45+ team was managed wonderfully by Rachel Thomas. The 45+ team comprised a great group of ladies playing with a significant amount of experience - some with 40+ years of hockey under their belts. With an inexperienced but keen goalie, the team won 10 out of 18 games and finished the regular season 3rd on the ladder, making finals in our debut season in this age group. Our dream ended on a rain drenched night at Doncaster in a penalty shootout, beaten by Footscray. Anna Mezzetti was voted MVP for the 45+ team, and was the top scorer for the season.



## Summer 2022

We're again fielding 3 teams in the 2022 'summer/mosquito' season and continue to pick up 'new to masters', 'new to hockey' and returning masters to add to our group. The Women's Masters section has also expanded to offer an Indoor Masters team, playing each week at Parkville and happily learning new skills.

We welcomed a couple of babies to the section this year - future HHC players no doubt - and are excitedly waiting to hear about a couple more, due in 2023!

Long term plans for the Women's Masters section are focussing on adding overall numbers to our group to guarantee 3 full teams each week in 2023. All players 32 and over are welcome!!
