Player fees explained

Players are required to pay fees to:

- 1. Hockey Australia (HA)
- 2. Hockey Victoria (HV)
- 3. Hawthorn Hockey Club (HHC)

Fees charged by Hawthorn Hockey Club include:

- Term 1 competitions Indoor Club Championships, T1 Indoor, T1 Outdoor, Special Training/Playing Events
- 2. Winter the regular hockey season, Premier League Levy (PL Levy), Volunteering Levy, PLR Levy
- 3. Term 4 competitions T4 Indoor, T4 Outdoor, Summer6s, Indoor Training sessions

To be eligible to play in any competition, HV requires that a player must be financially current with both HA and HV, with membership in the appropriate category. This payment includes the compulsory HA Player Insurance. If the club accidentally plays an ineligible player in a team, then the match is forfeited.

FAQ

When are fees due?

All fees are due and payable in advance of playing or upon receipt of invoice.

Why did I receive another invoice? I paid at the start of the year?

Upon receipt of an invoice, many people have said: "I paid fees at the start of the season".

Very true, players must have paid their HA & HV fees, otherwise they would not be an eligible player.

Club (HHC) fees are a separate charge and may have been issued during or towards the end of the season.
